Travelling to the ASCC at the STRIP

By car: The trip will take about 30 minutes from the city centre along the Monash Freeway. From Melbourne airport the trip takes 45 minutes.

By public transport: To get to Clayton campus by public transport, take any of the Dandenong, Pakenham or Cranbourne line trains to Huntingdale station then catch a bus to the campus. Buses leave the station for Clayton campus every 15-20 minutes. Alternatively, take the Glen Waverley line train to the Syndal train station and then bus along Blackburn Road.
